Stall information

All stalls are 8X8

Electricity is available for an additional charge of \$85. You must provide a surge protector.

Animals may not be kept in display stalls. The floor is concrete covered in plastic sheeting and straw. Please bring mats.

Space Sharing/Neighboring

Please specify if you will be sharing stall space with another exhibitor. The Registrar will make every effort to locate you near another exhibitor, however, if an exhibitor is a sponsor and has priority stall placement, non-sponsor requests may not be honored. Please include a diagram of the requested space arrangement, including electricity.

Stall Capacity

Each stall is limited to 2 adult/yearling alpacas, 3 juvenile alpacas OR 2 female alpacas with crias (<5 months old) at their side.

Alpaca Health Requirements

There will be a vet check performed on each alpaca, whether they are entered into the show or not, before it is admitted to the show venue. All alpacas must be sound, healthy, and free of internal and external parasites.

- A current Health Certificate or Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), dated February 26th, 2012 or later, is required for each on-site animal and must be presented at the check-in site before animals may enter the show venue. A copy of the CVI will be retained by the show. A copier will not be available on-site, so it may be necessary for you to leave the premises to obtain a copy if you do not bring one.
- Animals with diarrhea must be placed in quarantine area immediately.
- No animal may be housed in a vehicle or trailer in the parking lot.
- All alpacas entering the venue must be microchipped. The microchip number must be included on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI). IAO will have microchip readers, however it is advised that you have available a reader capable of displaying your brand of microchip.
- Please be advised – no dogs will be allowed at the show venue this year.
- All alpacas entering the show venue will be required to have proof of a negative PCR test for BVDV, on Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, or copy of form from lab.
- Exhibitors from outside the state are responsible for learning and meeting health requirements for interstate transport. We recommend you check to see what current transport regulations are in effect.

Animal Care

You must supply your own feed and water containers. You are responsible for cleaning your own stalls; please bring your own rake & shovel. Disposal of waste must be put in clearly marked containers.

Companion Animals

All companion animals must have a microchip and meet all alpaca health requirements. Please list your companion animal on the halter entry form.

Confirmation, Change & Cancellation Policy

Confirmation of receipt of complete paperwork will be sent out by email. If space is unavailable, you will receive a full refund. If you must cancel your stalls and entries, 75% of fees paid will be refunded if cancellations are received by February 18th. For existing registrations, changes or additional entries made between February 19th and March 3rd will be charged \$15 per change/entry. No changes, additional entries, or refunds will be allowed after March 3rd. New registrations between February 18th and March 3rd will be charged a \$25 late registration fee in addition to the \$15 per late entry fee.

*Any alpaca who is deemed to be not solid colored may move to the Small Processor division OR may remain in the Large Processor division with the knowledge that the alpaca will be disadvantaged, at the judge's discretion. The entire alpaca is evaluated for consistency of color.

Compliance checking will be at the discretion of the exhibitor. Color checking shall conform to the Mitchell color chart except for Bright White. There will be trained compliance checkers available for use at exhibitor request. Exhibitor is solely responsible for exhibiting their alpaca in the correct class AND the correct Show Division. Any alpaca in the incorrect color class will be disadvantaged, at the judge's discretion. Any alpaca not meeting the fleece minimums or over the fleece maximums will be disadvantaged, at the judge's discretion.
